

How to Use the 2010 Rotoff Golf Draft Kit

Shlink Lincoln Sports is proud to offer the [2010 Rotoff Golf Draft Kit](#). This year's [Rotoff Golf Draft Kit](#) not only includes our standard fantasy golf advice and cheat sheets but now you can monitor and follow your golfers stats all season long with our [Rotoff Golf Draft Kit](#) application.

The [Top 200](#) is an excel stat sheet of the Top 200 PGA Tour golfers over the last three years according to [Shlink Lincoln Sports'](#) unique [Rotoff](#) rating system. Each golfer is ranked in nine stat categories, weighted based on how often they play and how well they score, and given a **Unit** value. This **Unit** value is a golfer's worth in a [standard Draft Auction](#) of 100 **Units** and 10 golfers per team. A golfer's **Top 200** ranking is a three year rank, based on stats from 2007-2009.

[SLS 2009](#), [SLS 2008](#) and [SLS 2007](#) are sortable excel sheets and loaded with PGA Tour stats. You can search each sheet by golfer name, Wins, Top 10s, etc. to help you search for your team needs. Please note that these stats are for the FedEx Cup season only. At this time we do not use PGA Tour Fall Series statistics as the Fall Series is not used in [Rotoff Golf](#).

Outlook

Much like last year, another PGA Tour season starts with some uncertainty for the World #1. If 2009 is any indication of what to expect, don't count on Tiger missing too much time. 3 of the 4 majors this year are on courses that Tiger dominates (and the same 3 of 4 from the "Tiger Slam" in 2000-2001). I don't think he's going to want to miss this opportunity to shave a few more off of Nicklaus' major lead. If I had to bet I'd say he could return for the [Arnold Palmer Invitational](#), but no later than [The Masters](#) in April.

Tiger is the most dominant fantasy player in any sport. He leads all golfers in **RSA** at -14.27 and no one else has **Bonus** points in all seven **Segments**. He's the ultimate **TC** in Rotoff leagues, though beware of his slow starts, especially if he takes any extended time away from the game. The stats speak for themselves. 14 **Top 10s** in 17 **Events** in 2009. One word (that keeps coming up), domination!

Bottom line, he won't go for cheap, expect to pay 55+ in Auction formats. Be sure to get a few middle tier golfers to pick up the slack while Tiger is out of your starting lineup. As long as Tiger returns in 2010, there's no such thing as an overpay here.

Brand new for 2010 is the [Rotoff Golf Draft Kit](#) application, a fantasy golf stat analysis tool. We have stats for all golfers that have played in a PGA Tour event since 2007, that's over 600 golfers!

Log into the [Rotoff Golf](#) site and click on the "[PGA Draft Kit](#)" link at the top left. Once in the Draft Kit tool, type a golfer's name into the search bar and click on their name in the gray box to bring up their stats page:

Outlook

Quietly, Phil put together a great season in 2009 and despite the personal matters that arose last spring. If anyone can benefit from Tiger's indefinite absence it is Lefty.

Phil is notorious for starting the season with a bang (4 Wins since 2007 in the first 10 weeks). With a C+ and A+ in Segments 1 and 2 respectively, he's the perfect TC to start the season. Finishing in the Top 10 in over 33% of all his starts the last 3 years, you really can't go wrong with Mr. Mickelson. His Money List grades of A+ across the board are also worth noting in weekly winner leagues.

Unfortunately Phil won't go quietly in your Auction this year as everyone will likely be looking his way with Tiger's status up in the air. Don't be hesitant to overpay for Phil. Even at 45 Units you might have a steal on your hands. Anyone else think he's due for another Major win?

The initial page for each golfer is considered their “Total/All” page. This shows all their stats from 2007 to date. From there you select the stat view to help you manage your fantasy golf team.

From the “Total/All” screen you can use the Toggle Bar to manage your fantasy golf team:

You can view stats for all years (**Total**) or by individual years (**2007, 2008, 2009, 2010**). The Toggle Bar also has 48 different tournament views, including **WGC/P, Majors, Playoffs, Segments** and 37 2010 PGA Tour Tournaments:



Units (100) – This is a golfer's worth in a [standard Draft Auction](#) of 100 **Units** and 10 golfers per team. If you are not using a Draft Auction for your fantasy golf draft you I highly recommend it. It is the only way to “Tiger Proof” your fantasy golf league. **Units** are not view specific. .

Rank – Each golfer is ranked in nine stat categories, weighted based on how often they play and how well they score, and given a **Unit** value. This **Unit** value is a golfer's worth in a [standard Draft Auction](#) of 100 **Units** and 10 golfers per team. A golfer's **Top 200** ranking is a three year rank, based on stats from 2007-2009. All golfers ranked outside of the **Top 200** will have a rank of NR (no ranking). **Rank** is not view specific.

TC –You designate your **TC** at the beginning of every **Segment** and if your **TC** plays all four rounds and finishes in the **Bonus** you get double bonus points. The **TC** rating is a recommendation grade based on the following:

- A** = Bonus in 5+ Segments
- B** = Bonus in 4 Segments
- C** = Bonus in 3 Segments
- D** = Bonus in 2 Segment
- F** = Bonus in 1 Segments

TC rating is also a good indicator for performance in **Salary Cap** leagues.

Events – Total **Events Played**

AF/Finish – A golfer's average finish or finish for the selected view.

RSA – Rotoff Scoring Average is a golfer’s projected **Rotoff Golf** score per tournament. Because bogies and worse rarely play until the final rounds in **Rotoff Golf**, bogies are weighted less than +1 stroke. In addition this stat is a good indicator of performance in **Bestball** leagues.

Wins – Total number of **Wins** on the PGA Tour for selected view.

Bonus – **Bonus** points are awarded in **Rotoff Golf** for overall tournament finish as follows:

Win = 3 points
2nd = 2 points
3rd = 1 point

Top 10 – Total number of **Top 10s** on the PGA Tour for selected view.

C/W/D – Cuts, Withdrawals and Disqualifications

Eagles – Total eagles for selected view

Birdies – Total birdies for selected view

Bogies – Total bogies for selected view

Segments and Money List – The **Segment** and **Money List** grades are based on the following:

A = Plays 70% of the time
B = Plays 50% of the time
C = Plays 33% of the time
D = Plays 20% of the time
F = Plays > 20% of the time
No Grade = Has never played

+ (plus) = With **Bonus**
- (minus) = With **C/W/D** and **NO Bonus**

Bonus in any **Segment** will cancel **C/W/D** in the same **Segment**. **Money List** and **Segment** ratings are also a good indicator of performance in **Yahoo!** leagues for a specific grouping of tournaments.

Money List grades are a measure of how a golfer performs in specific PGA Tour events. Standard **Rotoff Golf** league weekly payouts are weighted for **Major** (5x) and **WGC/P** (2x) tournaments.

All **Segment** grades are based on the tournaments for the current PGA Tour season. So if a tournament has moved on the schedule it will not effect **Segment** grades for previous years. For example the FBR Open was in **Segment 1** in 2009, but as it moved to **Segment 2** in 2010, all grades reflect the FBR Open being in **Segment 2**.
